Ho-Chunk, among many Indigenous tribes, wore moccasins created from either deer, elk, or bear tan hides. Moccasins were adorned with quillwork or beadwork in a variety of colors. Moccasins are still worn today during traditional ceremonies and dancing in pow-wows.
